# Important information about the vehicle parade

To incidents in recent years during the vehicle parade through the village to speeding and spinning wheels, the cantonal police of Graubünden gave us an ultimatum: **The parade on the unmarked road must be absolutely orderly without exception!** 

In the event of non-compliance, the vehicle parade will be removed from the program for subsequent years without replacement. **Violations will be reported immediately to the race management and lead to immediate exclusion from the event.** 

The race management appeals for fair play from all participants so that Arosa ClassicCar can continue to open with the Corso.

### Technical car approval

Only for the categories Arosa Classic Trophy and Arosa Sport Trophy.

Hanspeter Halbeisen (Head of Technical Car Inspection) and Alex Maag (Race Director) would like to remind you that in the Arosa Classic Trophy & Sport Trophy categories, a fire extinguisher with a valid date of inspection must be present in the vehicle. In the Trophy categories, a fire extinguisher including a valid date must be present in the vehicle.

If the fire extinguisher is not present and / or does not comply with the required regulations, the race organizers reserve the right to reclassify the vehicle to the unrated class «Alpine Performance» class. See also the Autosport Switzerland Yearbook, Appendix J, page 29 and page 60, Art. 7.3.

### Final instructions for drivers

In order to ensure that the event runs smoothly, we would like to draw your attention to the following points:

#### NSK Standard Regulations for Hill Climbs / Framework Regulations for Uniformity and Competition

These regulations of Auto Sport Switzerland form the basis for the classification classes Arosa Classic Trophy, Arosa Sport Trophy, Competition Formula and Competition. The Alpine Performance (demonstration class) is run in according to the invitation to tender. The invitations to tender for the various classes can be found at www.arosaclassiccar.ch.

#### 3. Administrative car inspection

The administrative car inspection is located in the paddock area on the Ochsenbühlplatz in the race secretariat.

#### 4. Technical acceptance of wagons

For admission to the event, the wagon inspection must have been carried out in accordance with Yearbook ASS page 52 Art. 21.3 must have been carried out. Spot checks are carried out at the pre-start in Langwies. Please keep to the specified times!

Thursday: 09.45 a.m to 16.45 p.m at the paddock box Friday: 06.30 a.m to 07.45 a.m in front of the administrative car inspection (race secretariat). On Friday there will be no technical scrutineering in the paddock boxes.

#### 5. Driver briefing

The welcoming of the drivers and the briefing by the race management, paddock manager and core OC will take place on Thursday, August 30 at 17.00 p.m in the event hall. Driver briefing in the event hall is mandatory!

#### 6. Padock Ochsenbühl and Obersee

The large paddock is located on the Ochsenbühl next to the ice rink. The tent complex is designed in a way that the thoroughfares are one-way. Access to the facility is from the rear via Jöri-Jenny Strasse. The instructions of the paddock staff must be strictly followed.

Driving in the village, outside of race times and the race track is prohibited without a license plate. license plates are prohibited, and will be subject to increased police checks and also be punished.


The box allocation will be communicated on site from Thursday, August 30th. Your please refer to the tent plan, which is posted at the race secretariat, or ask the park manager.


As it is very cramped in the paddock, private vehicles and trailers must be to the trailer parking lot on the Oberseepromenade. The parking of private vehicles and trailers in the paddock is strictly prohibited, vehicles will be towed away for a fee!

#### 8. Safety equipment for drivers

The wearing of a head restraint approved by the FIA is mandatory for the Grand Prix Thoroughbred and Formula 1 cars of period G, if the vehicle structure permits. For all other drivers, the wearing of a head restraint device is in accordance with the provisions of Article 3, Chapter III of Annex L FIA (e.g. HANS) is optional, but highly recommended. For all participants in the competition class, the wearing of safety harnesses and helmets must be worn during training and race runs. Furthermore, all riders must wear flame-retardant clothing in accordance with the Autosport Switzerland clothing form Switzerland (for the competition classes incl. underwear, face protection, gloves, etc.) etc., for all other classes this is recommended). **Participants in all classes must wear a safety helmet in accordance with the FIA list of approved helmets 2024. In addition, the «Clothing form» must be completed and presented at the technical scrutineering Download forms at arosaclassiccar.ch/en/drivers** 

#### 9. Line-up for transfer to the pre-start in Langwies

Setting up the vehicles for the race fields is once again a challenge this year for the participants and the organizer. Please follow the instructions of the paddock staff. The line-up will take place on the run-out section after the finish to the height of the sports and congress center. Park your vehicle on the far right-hand side of the road in the direction of the finish and watch out for any vehicles coming from the run-out area.

#### Friday training line-up:

The line-up for training will be according to your start number.

#### Line-up for Saturday and Sunday races:

The starting order on Saturday and Sunday is analogous to the starting order on Friday (independent of Friday's practice times). It is easier for the line-up of the drivers, but also for the public to follow your attractive vehicles with the magazine.

#### Please note the timetable and follow the instructions of the paddock personnel.

The transfer to the pre-start in Langwies must be carried out with the greatest discipline. **The convoy will drive on a non-closed road with oncoming traffic.** The convoy will be accompanied by at least 3 police patrols. Please follow the instructions of the cantonal police.

#### 10. Training and Race

Please adhere strictly to the time schedule. Stay in the pre-start area close to your vehicle. As usual, all participants will drive directly after crossing the finish line, all participants will drive calmly and normally directly to the paddock. It is forbidden outside the official training times. At the pre-start any «tire warm-up maneuvers» are prohibited! Co-drivers are only allowed with the registered drivers in the Arosa Classic Trophy. Participants in the regularity class are prohibited from obviously or significantly slowing down on the race track. This regulation applies to all training and race runs, and the marshals are instructed to report violations to the race director immediately. Infringements will be reported to the jury immediately and may lead to exclusion from the event.

#### 11. Finish line

On the run-out track, approx. 100 meters after the finish, the following race field will be lined up during the training and the following races. It is therefore important that you initiate a braking maneuver immediately after crossing the finish line and pass the lined-up vehicles at walking pace!

#### 12. Timetable

The timetable is not binding, these are approximate times. It is the participants responsibility to find out about any delays or delays in the event. The race management will endeavor to inform the drivers via loudspeakers.

#### 13. «Parc fermé» for the Competition class

The location of the «Parc fermé» will be announced at the drivers briefing.

#### 14. Trash and waste

Please dispose of waste in the waste garbage cans provided. Waste oil and other liquids belong in the waste barrels provided for this purpose and under no circumstances into the sewage system or into the Obersee!

#### 15. Award ceremony

The award ceremony for all fields will take place on Sunday, September 1st, 2024 in the paddock or, depending on the weather conditions, in the event hall approx. 1/2 hour after the last vehicle has crossed the finish line. We will inform you via loudspeaker in the paddock Ochsenbühl and Obersee to keep you up to date. Prizes that have not been collected cannot be forwarded.

#### 16. Departure

Departure with trailers is only permitted after the end of the race on Sunday. Thank you for your understanding.


